feet footwork The use of the five positions of the feet in dancing frame Posture, body position, and arm position for the purpose of maintaining connection free turn or free spin To turn independently without any body contact freeze A stop no movement

Making Predictions Identifying Animal Tracks

To assemble or place (the feet) together in the air (usually in fifth position) during a jump attitude: The hip of the gesture leg is at 90°, the knee is bent, and the foot is pointed Attitude croisée devant: the leg is lifted to the front Attitude croisée derriere: the leg is lifted to the back avant, en: To the front Balanchine:

Heel splits (2 counts) keep weight on balls of feet move both heel out at the same time and then back together Hop (1 count) spring into the air taking off and landing with same foot Jump You ain't tried dancing them yet! All counts are 1&2 Cha cha or triple step step(1) right (&) left (2)right on the spot Or (1) left(&) right (3)left on
