- Who was the "Little Dancer"? - Little Dancer, Aged Fourteen (1881) is undoubtedly Edgar Degas's best-known sculpture, and the only piece he exhibited in his lifetime The wax original, currently in the collection of the National Gallery in Washington, DC, was shown in the Impressionist Exhibition of 1881, where it received mixed reviews
