The international response to the Nuremberg Trials was controversial Overall, the majority favored the trials as they brought to light the extent of the human rights violations conducted by the Nazis However, a small minority critiqued the trials as imposing retroactive justice upon the accused, while others believed that although many Nazi

The difference between the Nuremberg Trials and the TRC: A ...

The TRC used some of the ideas of the Nuremberg Trials as a basis for its own deliberations, which took place in Germany after the Second World War The Trials were a forum for punishing the atrocities committed during WW H, whereas the TRC wanted to learn the truth The purpose of the comparison between Nuremberg and the TRC is to highlight the
